April 4, 2016**

The Boonville City Council met in Regular Session on April 4, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers. The following officers were present: Becky Ehlers, Mayor Pro Tem; Irl Tessendorf, City Administrator; Charissa Mayes, City Counselor; and Teresa Studley, City Clerk. Mayor Julie Thacher was absent.

CALL TO ORDER – PLEDGE AND PRAYER

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. and Mr. Whitney Venable led the prayer after the pledge of allegiance.

ROLL CALL

The following Council Representatives were present: Whitney Venable, Susan Meadows, Ned Beach, Henry Hurt, Morris Carter, Becky Ehlers, Vanessa Dorman, and Michael Stock.

HEARING OF CITIZENS' COMMENTS

Ms. Sarah Gallagher, President of the Katy Bridge Coalition, gave a brief update to the Council on the ribbon cutting ceremony for the opening of Phase 1 of the Katy Bridge that was held on April 2. Ms. Gallaher stated that Governor and Mrs. Nixon, Bill Bryan, Director of Missouri Division of State Parks, and many more dignitaries, along with approximately 150 local citizens and visitors attended the ceremony. The Katy Bridge Coalition wanted to thank Kate Fjell, M.L. Cauthon III, Gary Nauman, and the Boonville Police Department for their assistance in making the celebration possible. Ms. Gallagher also thanked Irl Tessendorf, Mayor Thacher, and the City Council on the continued support of the project. Ms. Gallagher felt that the culmination of 12 years of work for Phase 1 is something that the City of Boonville can be proud of.

CONSIDER RESOLUTION R2016-05 AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOONVILLE TO APPLY FOR A RECREATIONAL GRANT FOR CLIFF DRIVE TRAIL PROJECT

Ms. Studley read the resolution in its entirety. Mr. Carter moved and Ms. Dorman seconded the motion for approval. Mr. Beach questioned the project. Mr. Tessendorf advised that there has not been any preliminary discussion to the project. Mr. Tessendorf advised that the City of Boonville was invited to apply for this grant that would connect the Katy Bridge to Harley Park by way of Cliff Drive. Mr. Tessendorf advised that there is a dumping problem in the area, which the City has been trying to clean up. He feels that by blocking off the roadway and making it a trail, it will help prevent any further dumping. Mr. Tessendorf stated that there is one property owner that the City would need to consider by allowing him access to his property from Cliff Drive. Mr. Beach confirmed with Mr. Tessendorf that the property owner only has access from Cliff Drive and not Morgan Street. Mr. Tessendorf confirmed that the only access was from Cliff

Drive. Mr. Tessendorf stated that the local share would be “In Kind” and there is only a minimum of 20% matching share for the project. Mr. Tessendorf stated that if there was to be cash out go on the project, he spoke with the TDD and they would be able to fund that. Mr. Tessendorf reported that there is a 2-year time span for allowed construction, but feels the project will not take that long. Roll call was taken on Mr. Carter’s motion. Ayes: Venable, Meadows, Beach, Hurt, Carter, Ehlers, Dorman, and Stock, Total (8); Opposed: None, Total (0); Absent: None, Total (0). Motion Carried.
