ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BOONVILLE, MISSOURI AMENDING AQUATIC CENTER ADMITTANCE FEES, PORTION OF THE SCHEDULE OF ADMINISTRATIVE FEES (APPENDIX G IN THE CODE OF GENERAL ORDINANCES); PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREFORE; AND REPEALING PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE

WHEREAS: The City of Boonville first adopted its Schedule of Administrative Fees as Ordinance No. 4018 on September 5, 2006 and has found it necessary to amend the fee schedule from time to time to respond to rising costs of services and other economic conditions effecting the administration of local government; and

WHEREAS: the attached Exhibit amending the Aquatic Center Admittance Fees portions of the Schedule of Administrative Fees, Revised April 15, 2025, is based on recovery of actual costs involved in providing this recreational activity for City residents, prospective residents, and guests.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOONVILLE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the City of Boonville, Missouri shall amend the **Aquatic Center Admittance Fees** portion of the Schedule of Administrative Fees (Appendix G in the Code of General Ordinances), prescribed and set forth in the amended portion of the **Schedule of Administrative Fees, Revised April 15, 2025** attached hereto as **Exhibit A** and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2: That the rates set forth herein, shall become effective April 15, 2025.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
